



→ What is serial fraud?

The automated industrial (re)production and distribution of fraudulent documents.

Serial fraud cluster

A grouping of fraudulent documents tied together either by the use of a common document template or by other associations.

docs based on 1 template in 1 client's dataset


22,084\* number of clusters with a lifespan of 1 day

Most serial fraud clusters have a lifespan of 1 day, meaning all the fraudulent attacks happen very rapidly and are coordinated to exploit vulnerabilities fast before the attacked business or institution can catch up.

In other words, serial fraudsters are highly organized and move swiftly. To properly defend yourself from serial fraud attacks, every second matters.
